February 20, 2020 Board Meeting

The Retirement Board meeting of the Public Employees' Retirement Board was called to order by Vice Chair King at 10:20 a.m., on February 20, 2020, in the PERS' Board Room, 693 W. Nye Lane, Carson City. Members present: Timothy Ross, Yolanda King, Dawn Huckaby, Todd Ingalsbee, Mark Stevens, and Brian Wallace. Members absent: None.

1. <u>PUBLIC COMMENT</u>

There were no public comments offered.

2. <u>DISABILITIES</u>

2.1 For the record, Dawn Huckaby stated that Applicant No. 18 works or worked for the same employer as herself, but she did not feel that would impair her vote. Yolanda King stated that Applicant Nos. 11, 19, and 21 work or worked for the same employer as herself, but she did not feel that would impair her vote.

On motion of Tim Ross, the Retirement Board voted unanimously to:

- 1. Approve permanent and total disability retirements for Applicant Nos. 1-13, as recommended by staff for the month of February 2020.
- 2. Approve reemployment requests by disability recipients, Applicant Nos. 14-19, as recommended by staff for the month of February 2020.
- 3. Deny reemployment requests for disability recipients, Applicant Nos. 20-22, as recommended by staff for the month of February 2020.

3. <u>INVESTMENTS</u>

- 3.1 Staff, Julia Bonafede of Jobs Peak Advisors, and Janet Becker-Wold of Callan presented the 2nd quarter fiscal year 2020 performance update for the PERS', Legislators', and Judicial funds. There was no action taken on this item.
- 3.2 There were no recommended changes to the Interim Investment Directives for the PERS', Legislators', and Judicial funds.

4. <u>BOARD</u>

- 4.1 Staff reviewed proposed changes to the Retirement Board's Fiduciary Policy Statement. On motion of Tim Ross, the Retirement Board voted unanimously to adopt the Board's Fiduciary Policy Statement, as submitted.
- 4.2 Staff reviewed the Board's Police & Firefighters' Retirement Fund Advisory Committee Policy. Staff mentioned that some issues have been identified that the Board may want to discuss and provide direction on how to proceed and also reviewed the history of the Committee. It was also mentioned that letters had been submitted from two Police/Fire Committee members with their comments regarding the issue of the employee vs. management seat. After discussion, Staff will take the policy to the Police/Fire Committee for Committee recommendations of proposed changes. No action was taken on this item.
